



The Award of SSVAPS (State Service Victorian Association of Photographic Societies) however, is for those people who have worked not only within their Club, but outside it at a wider, Statewide and even National or International level.

Most Clubs will have people who are well and truly deserving of either a Year Bar or an Award, so, Club Committees, start thinking – is there someone in **YOUR** Club worthy of acknowledgement in this way???
